MasterConsole Digital overview

Raritan's MasterConsole® Digital (MCD) KVM switches and 17" LED backlit LCD KVM(MCD-LED) switches feature KVM ports for 8, 16, or 32 servers and can be cascaded 2 levels to support up to 1024 connections at distances up to 150 feet (45 meters). It features the use of standard Category 5/6/6e unshielded twisted-pair (UTP) cables for connecting computers. Switch channels by hotkeys or OSD.

MCD is available as a single-user switch (MCD-108/MCD-116) and a dual-user switch (MCD-216/MCD-232). MCD also supports stereo audio by using MCD VGA combo cables or MCD HDMI CIMs. MCD-LED is available for a single user access at the rack (MCD-LED17108/MCD-LED17116).

Both MCD/MCD-LED KVM switches support the latest digital video user interfaces – DVI, HDMI, and DisplayPort. Maximum video resolution can be supported up to 1920x1200@75Hz(Analog) , 1920x1080(Digital) in 100 feet thru UTP cable connections by MasterConsole CIMs(MDCIMs) or MasterConsole KVM combo cables(MDUTP).
