

# Dominion® User Station Firmware Release Notes

## Dominion User Station Overview

The Dominion KX III & IV User Stations are self-contained appliances that provides users with high-performance IP access to remote servers and workstations connected to the KX III & KX IV KVM-over-IP switches, with optional CommandCenter integration. Additional access methods now supported: VMware virtual machines, limited web browser links and access via RDP, VNC & SSH. The User Stations have a powerful desktop user interface that is flexible and productive. Supporting multiple KVM-over-IP sessions over 1 to 4 monitors (DKX4-EUST), users can simultaneously access, view and control 8 or more servers.

The Dominion KX IV Enhanced User Station is a more powerful hardware version of the KX III User Station. It provides users with high-performance IP access to remote servers and workstations connected to the KX III & KX IV KVM-over-IP switches, with optional CommandCenter integration. The KX IV Enhanced User Station is up to 3 times more powerful than the KX III User Station, supporting up to four connected monitors. It is recommended for customers using the DKX4-101, 4K video sessions, multiple KVM-over-IP sessions and four connected monitors.

## Release 5.1.0 Firmware Overview

Dominion User Station Release 5.1.0 is a General Availability (GA) Release for applicable KX product groups. This release may include performance and productivity improvements, support for new products and accessories, new features and enhancements, bug fixes, and general fixes for specific model families. Specific updates are outlined below.

## Important Notes

- To upgrade, the User Station must be running the Release 5.0 firmware.
- This Release is certified to work with Dominion KX IV – 101 switches or Dominion KX III switches.
- The User Station does *NOT* work with the Dominion KX, KX II, LX, LX II, KSX II or other Raritan IP switches.
- The User Station integrates with Raritan's CommandCenter Secure Gateway, recommend CC-SG firmware version 12.0.
- During the upgrade process, the screen may be blank for several minutes, this is expected behavior. Upgrade will complete in approximately 7 minutes (9 minutes from CC-SG) and KUST will boot to the login screen.
- Upgrading from CC-SG: After selecting to run the upgrade, CC-SG remotely logs into the KXUST to transfer the upgrade file. This takes approximately 1 minute, then CC-SG logs out. An error message is then displayed on CC-SG instead of a success message. This is expected. The KXUST remains at the login screen for another 1-2 minutes, then the upgrade starts. Total time for upgrade is approximately 9 minutes.
